Mosanjae Peak of Hwangmaesan Mountain



Mosanjae Peak (767m) is part of Hwangmaesan Mountain, made up of a huge rock, often compared to tendons of a strong man. On the top of the mountain is Mujigaeiso, one of the most desirable, propitious sites for a grave.

Birth Home of Jo Sik



Birth home of Jo Sik (1501–1572), famous scholar of Neo-Confucianism in the middle of the Joseon Dynasty, who was as great as Yi Hwang. The site has been designated as Gyeongsangnam-do Monument No. 148.

Yeongsamsa Temple Site



A site of the temple below magnificent rock formations and cliffs of Mosanjae Peak of Hwangmaesan Mountain. Do not miss a number of sculptures such as the twin-lion stone lantern (National Treasure No. 353) and the three-story stone pagoda (National Treasure No. 480) made during the Unified Silla period.

Gayasan Mountain



One of Korea's twelve most celebrated mountains with a number of 1,000m-high peaks such as Sangwangbong Peak (1,430m), Duribong Peak, which is a jagged rock peak, Namsan, Bigyeon, as well as wall-like fantastic rock formations.

Daejanggyeong Theme Park

Hongnyudong Valley



The valley stretching from Gayasan Mountain to the entrance of Haeinsa Temple. The name of the valley comes from exquisite autumnal colours of the trees which would dye even the waters. Nongsanjeong is the place where Choe Chiwon, a Confucianism philosopher of the late Silla period, lived in seclusion.

Maehwasan Mountain (Namsanjeilbong Peak)



The rock formations of Namsanjeilbong Peak (1,010m) resemble plum blossoms, where the name of the mountain comes from. On the top of the mountain are seven jagged rock peaks, creating a splendid view.
